

Michel Cuney (1948) holds a PhD in Geology from the Institut National Polytechnique de Lorraine in Nancy. Michel is Director of Research at CNRS, at the GéoRessources laboratory in Nancy. He is honored with the SGA-Newmont Gold Medal, an international award that recognizes forty years of original research on uranium. He is a Fellow of the Society of Economic Geologists and was a Thayer Lindsley Lecturer of the Society of Economic Geology in 2010. He also received the Barbier Prize from the Société Géologique de France in June 2013, testifying to an excellent work of scientific research, in connection

with the industry. Michel is one of the world's leading specialists in uranium geology. He has visited and worked on almost all important uranium deposits of the world. He has published more than 200 scientific papers and published or participated to the publication of 15 books.
